

CROOK COUNTY FIRE & RESCUE

The regular meeting of Crook County Fire & Rescue was called to order by Jerry Brummer at 9:05 am on February 16, 2016.

Board members present were Jim Dean, Jerry Brummer, Steve Lent, Dale Pedersen and David Armstrong.

Staff present was Matt Smith, Casey Kump, Russ Deboodt and Paula Landrus.

MINUTES

Steve Lent made a motion to approve the minutes from the January 19, 2016 meeting. Dale Pedersen seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Standard of Cover – Matt Smith stated that page 8 was an overview of each response area. Matt read the Risk Management to the Board. Matt said that page 9 is the Structure Fire Response. On page 9 is also Emergency Medical Response for 2015. In 2015 81% of 2,228 of the 2733 requests for service inside the Fire District were medical calls. Matt went over page 10 how many responders the District has. Page 11 Matt talked about Planned Daily District minimum Staffing Level at station 1201, 1202 and 1203. Matt discussed the Response times, in 2015 CCFR arrived on scene within 12 minutes of dispatch 85% of the time within the district boundaries. Matt stated that page 12 summarizes the entire document.

Steve Lent made a motion to approve Crook County Fire & Rescue Standard of Cover. David Armstrong seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Enterprise Zone-Matt Smith read the policy for the Enterprise Zone. Matt would like to get support from the police and sheriff. He would like to form a board for emergency services, to make sure that we are heard. Matt stated that he had sample copies of negotiations from Moro County.
