MINUTES

Steve Lent made a motion to approve the minutes from January 19, 2023. George Ponte seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

CONSENT AGENDA

George Ponte made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Jerry Brummer seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Senate Bill 762-Chief Matt Smith gave an update on the bill. There has been some discussion on the map possibly going away. There are three bills in the legislature that may change SB 762.

Seismic Grant- Chief Smith stated that the Board awarded the contract to Kirby Nagelhout Construction.

Kirby Nagelhout is reviewing the contract and we will have a meeting with them.

NEW BUSINESS

Standard of Cover-Chief Smith stated this is a report card for the fire district. We review this every year. The Board reviewed the document. Crook County Fire & Rescue was requested for service 3669 times in 2022. Of those requests 88.2% were for medical related calls. There were 2500 total calls within the 1201 area, 190 total calls in the 1202 area and 407 total calls in the 1203 area. The Board discussed the Standard of Cover document.

Steve Lent made a motion to approve the Standard of Cover. George Ponte seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
